Message from the President

Welcome to Southern Tasmanian Badminton Association's Newsletter.

It is with great pleasure that I can advise that our membership is approaching 400. It's great to see our numbers increasing and using the centre. Rule for Serving

There has been some confusion over the serving rules. We are using the old rules (see below). The new rule of being able to serve at a height of 115cm only applies to National and International tournaments, where the special equipment and Service Judges are available.

9.1.6 a) the whole shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib;

b) the shaft and the racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction.
