If there are two words to describe 2021, they would be *game changing*. 2021 not only saw the installation of our new floor, but also taking out part of the wall between courts 8 and 9 – creating a continuous pathway from courts 1 to 12. This work represented the biggest capital investment in our hall since the extension in the 90's.

This was the result of numerous years of planning and decision making and not a decision which was made lightly. When considering our new floor, there were dozens of factors which influenced our decision – *how hard is it to clean, how long will it last, how forgiving is it on our knees?* These types of decisions can be agonising and which such a large cost associated with the project, it's not something you want to get wrong.

It's been so encouraging and heart-warming to hear all the positive comments about our new floor, so I'm confident that we made the right choice. This wouldn't have been possible without the help of a few key people, who I'd like to give special mention to:

- Vicky Zhang – for working with Gerflor to facilitate the installation of the new courts
- David Needham – for making yourself available on-site during installation, to assist with any issues Gerflor had
- Nathan Bevin – for securing the \$50 thousand dollar grant to resurface our hall and for originally setting up Skedda to book out our surplus courts

And finally, to our members, for supporting the STBA by booking courts, playing in pennants, and trusting the committee to both raise and expend the necessary funds for such a major project. Without you, none of this would have been possible.

I've always been extremely proud to call myself a Tasmanian and never more so than the last 18 months. While the rest of Australia and the rest of the world continues to be ravaged by the Coronavirus pandemic, we in Tasmania have been extremely fortunate to be sheltered from the virus and for the most part have been able to live a relatively normal life. Of course, there are some small changes and I'd like to thank everyone for doing the right thing and checking into our hall each time and following our Covid safety plans.

This has been one of the busiest years on record for the STBA. We've continued to run our flagship pennant offering and have run three pennants with four divisions in each.

Our lightning rosters remain popular, with 15 separate events held over the past 12 months, including the launch of the new paired doubles format which has proved to be extremely popular amongst our members and have become somewhat of a regular Sunday evening staple now.

We continue to offer our Super Smash program during school terms on a Saturday morning and we've just recently introduced a third *gold* division for the first time ever. A huge thanks must go out to Alicia Morgan for coordinating and running the super smash program. I'm not sure how you're able to manage 80 kids running around the hall on a Saturday afternoon, but you're able to make it work, and make it work well.

After Covid disrupted part of our tournament season last year, Badminton Tasmania ran a compressed season later in the year last year and have stretched the tournament season this year. As a result of this, the STBA have only held two tournaments in the past 12 months: the *Tasmanian Titles* last November, and the *STBA invitational*, the first sanctioned tournament on our new floors in July.

Both events saw a record-breaking number of participants with over 150 people participating in over 210 matches in the Tasmanian Titles which was followed up with over 180 people playing in over 275 matches in the STBA invitational. Despite these amazing numbers, we still managed to finish on time and both Rob and Vicky need to be congratulated for their tireless work in coordinating and managing these tournaments as without either of you, things wouldn't go nearly as smoothly.

And yet, even after you consider everything above, we still managed to have spare capacity in our hall to book our courts. After launching in 2019, our online booking platform Skedda has quickly become our biggest source of revenue for our club and has enabled us to undergo a huge shift in the operational structure of our organisation. The revenue we receive from court bookings has allowed us to invest in our staff, Alicia Morgan and Luke Warrener who have become the face of the STBA and have taken on many of the daily duties required in a small business. I'll be the first to admit that the handover hasn't been the smoothest, but with each passing day things become slightly more clearer. Your patience and professionalism has been nothing short of amazing and your value and contributions to the STBA are immeasurable.

I'd also like to thank our extremely talented and skilled committee. Although we may have staff to take on some of the day to day work, there is still a significant time commitment involved in being on the committee. Whether it's the photography and design work that Keiko does, the maintenance coordination that David oversees, the HR/WR work that Alison follows up for us, Casim's help with our pennants, tournaments and other offerings, or Vicky's tireless work with both our finances and assisting with staff queries – the work you do is definitely appreciated by not only myself, but by many of our members.

I've made the difficult decision not to stand for president in the upcoming year. As the STBA continues to shift away from our old operating model and towards our new, I am simply unable to meet the time commitments required in a role which is essentially a small business manager. I've been extremely grateful to be your president for the past two years, but am looking forward to taking a step back and assisting where I can.

I'd like to close this by saying that we have something special here. There are very few badminton clubs in Australia (or possibly even the world) that have the luxury of maintaining their own dedicated facilities like we do. For this reason alone I think we're quite unique and think that it's extremely important for all future committees to consider this in their decision making. The committee is elected by its members who place faith and trust in us to make the best decisions for our members, for our staff, for our facilities and for our club.

SOUTHERN SCHOOLS BADMINTON ROSTERS REPORT 2021

In 2021 the STBA held schools' rosters for grade 7 – 10 and combined grade 11 – 12 rosters. These were held at the new time over Term 3. Starting on the 21st July and finishing the 17th September.

- 11 – 12 rosters held on Wednesday afternoon
 - Held at STBA.
 - **100+ players, 23 teams, 3 divisions.**
- 7 – 10 rosters held on Friday afternoons
 - Held at STBA and a further 9 participating school gymnasiums.
 - **350 + players, 76 teams, 14 divisions.**
 - 35 matches each week.

This is an increase of 19 teams from 2019.

The individual championships were held over 3 afternoons towards the end of the rosters. A total of 251 players enters the championships making it the most participated tournament in Tasmania for the 3rd year running.

Of the 18 schools involved The Friends School was awarded winner of the Ampol Cup for most successful school on the back of having 21 teams across all the rosters with many making the finals. Below are the results from the rosters.

I would like to acknowledge Life members Rose and Greg Meaghan who have been outstanding in their support for the schools' rosters. They volunteered their time each week to be at the STBA center and played a vital role in court allocation / management during the schools' championships.
